## **Contemporary China's Foreign Policy Issues**

Рабочая учебная программа по дисциплине “Contemporary China’s Foreign Policy Issues” на английском языке разработана в соответствии с Федеральным государственным образовательным стандартом высшего профессионального образования. Рабочая учебная программа включает цели освоения дисциплины; место дисциплины в структуре ООП бакалавриата; компетенции обучающегося, формируемые в результате освоения дисциплины; структуру и содержание дисциплины; образовательные технологии; учебно-методическое обеспечение самостоятельной работы студентов, учебно-методическое и информационное обеспечение дисциплины; материально-техническое обеспечение дисциплины, вопросы для подготовки к зачёту и экзамену.

### **1. Цели освоения дисциплины**

Этот курс разработан, чтобы предоставить студентам основы современных исследований в области внешней политики Китая на современном этапе.

Цель этого курса - передать студентам знания о вопросах внешней политики Китая. Принимая во внимание растущую роль Китая в мировых политических и экономических отношениях, важно научить студентов, изучающих международные отношения, об этой восходящей сверхдержаве, которая создает независимый политический и экономический полюс.

The main aim of this course to pass knowledge about China’s foreign policy issues to students. Taking into consideration the growing role of China in world’s political and economic relations, it is important to teach students, who do their research on International Relations about this raising superpower, which creates independent political and economic pole.

### **2. Место дисциплины в структуре ООП**

Этот курс будет посвящен основным направлениям, целям и задачам внешней политики современного Китая. В ходе лекций, семинаров и обзоров специальной литературы будут обсуждаться следующие вопросы: основные цели и направления внешней политики современного Китая, многосторонняя политика Китая в ШОС, РИК, БРИКС, СБ ООН и его двусторонние отношения с Арменией, Россией, США, ЕС, Индией, Японией, КНДР, РК, Азербайджаном, Грузией и рядом государств Ближнего Востока и Северной Африки (Турция, Саудовская Аравия, Иран, Египет) а также сотрудничество с государствами Центральной Азии. Одной из основных целей этого курса является также ознакомление студентов с китайской инициативой «Один пояс, один путь» и обсуждение путей, с помощью которых Армения может быть вовлечена в главную инициативу Китая в 21 веке.

This course will focus on the main directions, aims and challenges of the contemporary China’s foreign policy. The following issues will be discussed during the lectures, seminars and reviews of the special literature: the main aims and directions of foreign policy of contemporary China, Beijing’s multilateral policy in the SCO, RIC, BRICS, UNSC, and its bilateral relations with Armenia, Russia, the US, EU Japan, DPRK, ROK, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Iran and Egypt as well as China’s cooperation with Central Asian states. One of the main aims of this course is also to give some knowledge to students about China’s Belt and Road Initiative and discuss the ways with which Armenia can be involved in China’s main initiative for 21st century.
