Introduction

- Linguistics of Diplomatic Discourse (English) is a compulsory subject that is part of the module World Politics and International Relations of Master students (first, second and third semesters).
- The aim of the course is to develop communicative skills in English (listening and reading comprehension and written and oral expression, communicative interaction and mediation) at B1+ level in multiple contexts, specifically politics, international relations, diplomacy and related areas, like, press, public policy, diplomatic politics, etc.
- At the same time, the course aims to promote autonomous learning, self-assessment, and remedial work with the lecturer.
- Students develop the skills to analyze and translate/interpret.
- Recommended previous knowledge and competences: students will need a minimum B2+ level of English.
- The course encompasses 72 academic hours of practical classes during the first semester with four academic credits and an examination at the end, 72 academic hours of practical classes during the second semester a credit/test at the end of the second semester and 72 academic hours of practical classes during the third semester.

Competences (General and Specific) and learning outcomes

General

- The aim of the course is to teach the language of diplomatic communication in English with its peculiarities, covering the most important areas of diplomatic communication, to develop stable knowledge and skills related to professional communication, introducing students to the features of political and diplomatic communication, promoting their active mastery. During the course students are given the opportunity to make speeches/presentations, written work aiming to develop their professional knowledge, skills and abilities in the English language.
- Students translate texts on diplomacy and international relations.
- Listening comprehension is improved via recordings/video materials.
- The development of interpersonal skills and the capacity for teamwork. Participating in small groups in group work and group projects.

- The development of the capacity for individual work, independent learning, organizational skills and time management. Taking responsibility for one's own learning with some monitoring on the part of the lecturer. Being confident and flexible in identifying and defining problems and being able to apply the appropriate knowledge, tools/methods to solve them.
- The ability to design and manage projects and write reports, presentations and papers. The students will be able to examine and develop: text organisation, point of view, paraphrasing, summarising, and argumentative communication.

Specific

- The development of communicative and social competence in the English language (listening and reading comprehension and written and oral expression, communicative interaction and mediation).
- Development of competence to apply the language of diplomacy and international relations; make a public speech on one of the covered topics.
- Reproduce information received from the media and express an opinion on it. Analyze the language of diplomacy.
